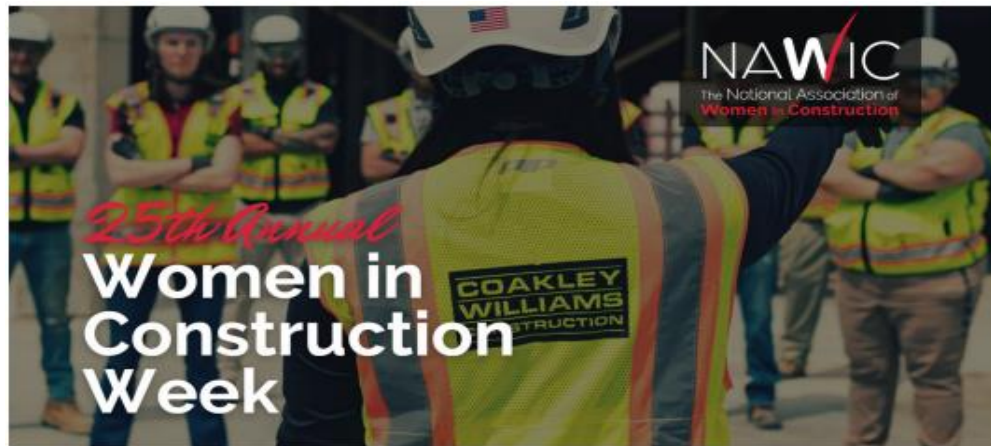
I am so blessed to be part of this organization and specifically the Fort Worth chapter. With your participation, we will keep Fort Worth Chapter #1 the leader within the organization.
